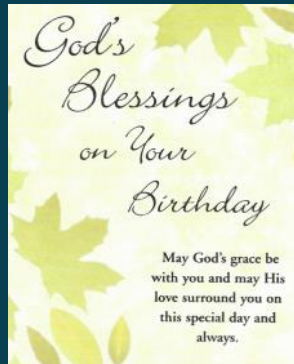

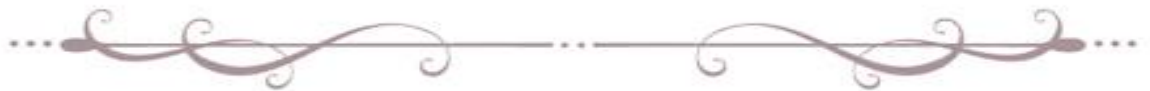

I wish to thank you for the visiting of church members and also for the arrangement of lovely flowers. Thank you so much. The thoughtfulness and floral gift is much appreciated.

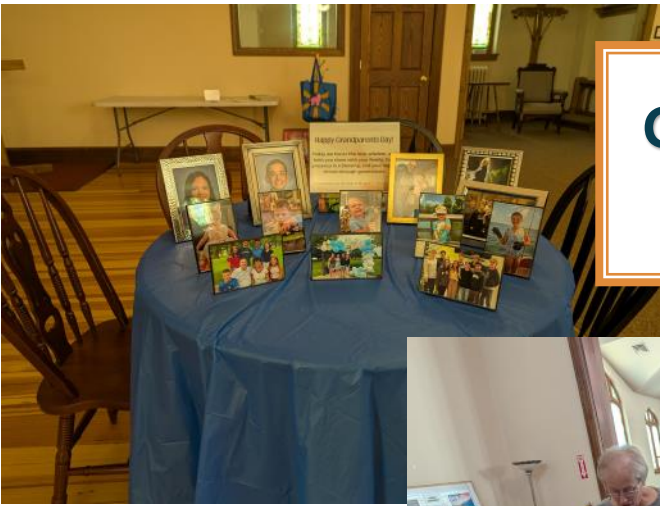
